### Session #1

Seek first an Understand & Begin with the end in 'Mind'

Bible Study:

Note:

The major theme of the 39 books of the Old Testament (Covenant) is to illuminate the history of Israel and the promise of atonement, reconciliation and eternal fellowship (Our Savior)

The major theme of the 27 books of the New Testament (Covenant) highlights the manifestation and fulfillment of the Seed of Promise in the person of Jesus Christ, and the establishment of His Kingdom, Priesthood and Church.

Central Theme ~ Throughout Scripture:

God, for His own glory has chosen to create and gather to Himself a portion of mankind to be the subjects of His eternal kingdom through whom He will display His wisdom, power, grace & glory.

### Session #2

Mosaic Law

- ◇ Moral [Ten Commandments; contained within two; supported by Love]
- ◇ Ceremonial [Established the Priesthood, consecrated Aaron as High Priest & the Levites]
- ◇ Judicial [Government as established by the Word of God, Godly directive | truth]

Patriarchs

- ◇ Adam [Intimate relationship, direct contact with the Father; received God's law]
- ◇ Noah [One man's righteousness saves an entire family | household | creation]
- ◇ Abraham [The father of promise, his belief was accounted to him as righteousness]
- ◇ Isaac [The son of promise, the heir of promise; progenitor of the seed of promise]
- ◇ Jacob | Israel [The nation, chosen people according to the promise; 12 Elders & Apostles]

Israel, a chosen people and Godly Nation

- ◇ Prophets [Major v. Minor] Samuel, Hannah dedicated him to the Lord
- ◇ Priests [Established by ceremonial component of the Law] [Eli & Samuel]
- ◇ Judges [Deborah, Samson, Gideon]
- ◇ Kings [Saul & David]

Davidic Covenant (2 Sam 7:8-17) [God's promise for an eternal kingdom]

A Kingdom Divided [Split after Solomon] [Judah, preserved for the manifestation of the Seed]



### Session #3

#### Matriarchs

- ◇ Tamar [Prostitution & Incest; Mother of Perez, Boaz, Obed, Jesse]
- ◇ Rahab [Gentile & Prostitute; Mother of Boaz, by Salmon]
- ◇ Ruth [Moabite & Idolater; Wife of Boaz and mother of Obed]
- ◇ Bathsheba [Adultery & Deception; wife of Uriah; slept w/King David; mother of Solomon]
- ◇ Mary [Single mother; endured the stigma of being pregnant outside of wedlock]

#### New Testament “Religious” Sects & Authority

- ◇ Pharisee [Separatist, ritualistic sect of Jews; used human tradition to nullify Scripture]
  - Adhered strictly to ceremonial fine points of the law
  - Believes in resurrection, angels & spirits
- ◇ Sadducee [Liberal, compromisers & political sect of Jews; sympathizer w/Roman Gov’t]
  - Denies things supernatural i.e. resurrection, angels & spirits; Acts 23:7-8
  - Political opportunists who rejected human tradition and scorned legalism
- ◇ Scribe [Primarily Pharisees; authority concerning Jewish law]
  - Professional scholars specializing in explaining the application of the law
  - Lawyers, recorders & researchers of the Law
- ◇ Elder [Member of the great Sanhedrin; the Supreme Court of Israel]
  - [Enforce Jew law] Sanhedrin Council; 71 members; High-Priest presided over
  - No power to administer capital punishment; under Roman government
- ◇ High Priest [Melchizedek & Aaron] [Caiaphas, Roman & Herodian sympathizer]
  - During the days of Herod the Sadducees controlled to temple
